Equipment needs include: - Truck or Minivan to haul the sukkah components from the big white shed to behind the JFC - Sturdy 5-foot or 6-foot step-ladders - Heavy-duty cordless drills/drivers - Hedge trimming equipment to prune any overhanging foliage

- Safety equipment: goggles, gloves and hard-hats

The construction team should wear long sleeves, long pants, sturdy shoes and must wear hard hats, gloves and eye protection. We will be hauling and fitting large, heavy boards to assemble our 48 x 12 x 8 foot sukkah.
