This Week at OSTT/Olney

We are pleased to welcome back world-renowned Chazzan Yaakov Motzen to the Olney community

Chazzan Motzen is a native of Tel Aviv and the fifth generation of a family of Cantors. He attended well known Yeshivot in Israel and studied music and vocal technique with the late Yosef Goland, the principal baritone in the Berlin opera in the late 1920's.

Yaakov studied liturgy with the renowned Cantor Yitzchak Eshel, and served as vice president of the Nachala organization from 1973-1978, which was dedicated to entertaining wounded soldiers. Chazzan Motzen held the position of Chief Cantor in Givatayim, Haifa, and Ramat Gan, and sang on Kol Yisrael radio and television. From 1978 to 2005, he served as Chazzan in various synagogues in Canada.

In November of 1987 and 1988, he joined several other outstanding cantors in a historical tour behind the Iron Curtain, organized by the American Society for the Advancement of Cantorial Arts and the Gila and Haim Wiener Foundation. Yaakov Motzen has performed in concert in many parts of the world, including Australia, South Africa, England, Israel, and many cities in North America (including Olney!). He has released over a dozen recordings of liturgical and Chassidic music. Chazzan Yaakov Motzen is a proud father of six children, and "saba" to seventeen grandchildren.
